Johnson & Billick: Vikings Have the Edge Over Undefeated Saints in NFC

FOX SPORTS' ALLSTATE BCS SELECTION SHOW UNVEILS MATCHUPS FOR COLLEGE FOOTBALL'S JEWEL EVENTS — Following Sunday's NFL Doubleheader action on FOX, the network presents its fourth ALLSTATE BCS SELECTION SHOW. All questions surrounding January's Bowl Championship Series games will be answered as FOX Sports' **Chris Rose** and BCS on FOX lead game analyst **Charles Davis** join National championship-winning coach **Jimmy Johnson** to unveil the much-anticipated BCS match-ups. Once the selections are made, other members of the BCS on FOX broadcast team will be in place at the campuses in the running for a BCS Bowl selection. Potential sites include: Florida, Alabama, Texas, TCU, Boise St. and Iowa.

NFC EAST RIVALS RUMBLE IN JERSEY – The 2009 NFL on FOX campaign rolls into Week 13 on Sunday, Dec. 6 with doubleheader coverage of seven enticing matchups. At 1:00 PM ET, **Drew Brees** and the high-flying, undefeated Saints march in Washington to take on the Redskins. **Michael Vick** makes his return to Atlanta with the Eagles to take on the Falcons. In Cincinnati, **Carson Palmer** and the Bengals welcome **Matthew Stafford** and the Lions in a matchup of high profile QBs. Rams at Bears and Bucs at Panthers round out early game action. At 4:15 PM ET, **Tony Romo** and the NFC East-leading Cowboys enter the Meadowlands to face **Eli Manning** and the Giants. **Joe Buck**, **Troy Aikman** and **Pam Oliver** call the action from Giants Stadium. The NFL on FOX closes out its Week 13 action with the 49ers and Seahawks getting together for an NFC West battle in Seattle.

Coverage begins at 12:00 PM ET with America's most-watched pregame show, FOX NFL SUNDAY. **Terry Bradshaw** and **Curt Menefee** co-host the Emmy Award-winning program and are joined by analysts **Howie Long**, **Michael Strahan** and **Jimmy Johnson**. JOHNSON: SAINTS OR VIKINGS IN SUPER BOWL? – FOX NFL SUNDAY analyst and former Super Bowl-winning head coach **Jimmy Johnson** leans towards **Brett Favre** and the Vikings over the currently undefeated Saints but not by much. “I give the Vikings the edge over the Saints right now because of their defense. Their defense is steadier,” said Johnson. “They can make more plays with the pass rush without a lot of blitzing and I’ve been impressed with how well Minnesota’s secondary has held up, too, without **Antoine Winfield**, their best cornerback, these past five games.”

BILLICK: “MINNESOTA’S RUN-STOPPING ‘D’ + FAVRE + PETERSON GIVE THEM EDGE OVER SAINTS” – “Coming off Monday night’s game, it’s hard not to say the New Orleans Saints are the best team in football right now,” said NFL on FOX analyst **Brian Billick**. “**Peyton Manning** has done a phenomenal job with the comeback but the Colts have shown a little bit of their vulnerability, as little as you can have at 11-0. It’s still hard for me not to come back to the Minnesota Vikings. I’m not sure if the Vikings have been tested quite like the Saints were Monday night but they’re impressive on both sides of the ball. Who is playing better than **Brett Favre** right now? Favre combined with an absolutely dominating run-stopping defense and Favre’s ability at the end of the day to hand the ball off to **Adrian Peterson** makes it hard to think Minnesota still isn’t the best.”

NFL ON FOX NATIONAL GAME IS TELEVISION’S NO. 1 SHOW – The NFL on FOX National Game ranks as the highest-rated and most-watched NFL game and is the No. 1 program in all of television across all key male and adult demos this season, according to figures released today by Nielsen Media Research. The FOX National Game is averaging an outstanding 15.4/29 household rating/share and 26.0 million viewers through six broadcasts, up +11% over last year’s season-to-date rating (13.9/27) and up +16% in average audience (22.5 million). FOX’s 15.4 rating and 26.0 million viewers is +19% and +21% better, respectively, than CBS’s National Game (12.9, 21.4 million) and +31% and +33% better, respectively, than NBC’s Sunday Night Football (11.8, 19.5 million).
